

Bethany's ECC Daycare is maintaining very well now. We continue to be at our maximum enrollment until we can open up the other room with a Lead Teacher, and that's coming.


Meanwhile, we have applied for the next grant of COVID relief money from Child Care Aware, and are expecting to learn if we are approved just any day now.
