Brothers and sisters in Christ,

Take a moment to call upon the name of God- Father, Son and Holy Spirit, recalling His Promise to you in your baptism. Because, so often we are tempted to dismiss the wholeness and completion we already have in Christ, Jesus. The devil wants us to believe there is something left for us to do, something we must achieve before we are finally right before God. We tend to focus on who we want to be, who we are told we need to be and who we can become rather than who we already are to God in His Son.

From Colossians we read,

"See to it that no one takes you captive by philosophy and empty deceit, according to human tradition, according to the elemental spirits of the world, and not according to Christ. For in him the whole fullness of deity dwells bodily, and you have been filled in him, who is the head of all rule and authority" (Colossians 1:8-9).

Look to your baptism, for there you see that you are already whole, complete, and identified in God in the most holy and blameless way - through Christ. Therefore, base all things upon who you already are in Christ rather than upon who your sinful flesh deceives you to believe you need to be or want to be.

I write this to each of you individually, and also a congregation. As the people of God, our Lord commands us to preach and teach Christ, our completion and wholeness in God. This doctrinal truth pervades all things in the life of the congregation- Word and Sacrament, instruction in doctrine from cradle to grave, Bible study, fellowship, stewardship, and outreach. We preach and teach Christ, not the Christian.

This is the importance behind sound doctrinal instruction in the faith from infancy on. What a blessing from the Lord! Praise God! In His Peace and Joy!

SUNDAY HAPPENINGS


Service 9:00 AM Fellowship Time 10:00 to 10:30 AM Sunday School/Bible Study 10:30-11:30 AM

DINING ROOM- Pastor Schnelle leads a study of the book "The Messiah". In 8 sessions, the study helps participants see Jesus revealed in the Old Testament. The book includes daily readings, questions and discussion prompts.

PRAYER CENTER - Robert Bolin leads a study of the book entitled "God's Law & Gospel" which explores knowing the difference between them, and how to avoid mixing them; and how the Holy Spirit works through both to bring people to faith in Jesus Christ and keeps them there.

SECOND CLASSROOM– Mark Dehncke leads a study of the book entitled "Grace - An Invitation to a Way of Life". The book offers that most Christians understand the concept of being saved through grace, but fail to understand that grace is a daily experience under which they live.

THIRD CLASSROOM - Sunday School is lead by teachers in a rotation schedule. **Classes start again on September 18th. There will be an opening in the Sanctuary and a lesson to follow.** More information will be posted in the Sunday News Notes and on a bulletin board in the northeast hallway by the door to the parking lot.



Early Childhood Center Update

Bethany's Early Childhood Center is perking right along. The operation is solid and healthy. We are pretty much filled to capacity, but we have our challenges:

While we are licensed for 60 children, we have been limited to having no more than 44, due to the number of lead-qualified Teachers we've had recently. To remedy this, so we can fulfill our full potential, we have been trying to hire a new Lead Teacher, but it's been difficult. Hiring in today's economy and today's society is challenging. We have been consistently advertising, and we have gotten a number of applicants, but many of them are

not qualified. We have arranged to interview a number of the applicants, but over half of those who promise to come for an interview never show up, and don't even call to excuse themselves. We will redouble our efforts. Please pray that the right person will be sent to us!

Meanwhile, Taryn has recently returned to work, which has freed up our Director, Danita, to spend more of her time doing the work of a Director, rather than teaching. Taryn has also stepped-up to take over the regular Custodial duties within the areas of the building that are used by our children. The arrival of monthly disbursements of the "Round 3 Sustainability Grant" means that we can now get a permanent, high-quality changing table for the youngest group in our Daycare, and we are assured that Bethany's overall financial health is secure for the year. Now if only we can find one more lead-qualified Teacher......

Well, keep praying for us as we strive to accomplish our mission to care for the little ones entrusted to us while we introduce them to the basics of the Christian faith. Your continued support is VERY appreciated!!!




